Interpretive Solutions consulted with Cuyahoga Valley National Park regarding visitor experience planning for park facilities, with a particular focus on six of the park's visitor centers. The park's interpretive staff posed two important questions: Are the visitor centers providing maximum value to visitors? How could they be made more effective? After completing a scoping trip in November 2008 and subsequent research and analysis over a two month period, IS conducted a two-day workshop, during which the project team addressed the answers to those questions.
